Once you have answered the questions to the best of your ability, click the submit button. You will be asked if you are sure you want to submit. Click yes.

[00:00:58] The Self-Check will be immediately graded, and will give you feedback on each question so you can learn what you might have missed. The percentage correct will appear here in the top right corner, and a letter grade will appear next to the assignment in the navigation pane. You may have the option to retake the Self-Check to improve your score. To do that, click the retake button here.
